## **Brief introduction of the college and vidyapeetha.**

SJMV's BAJSS Arts and Commerce College for Women is run by SMJ Vidyapeetha, Chitradurga. Established in July 1979 the college is devoted to disseminating knowledge to the women folk of rural area since 30 years. It provides under graduate education in Arts and Commerce programme. The college has its own spacious building in the core of the city. The campus has an area of 1.25 acres in which a well equipped library, computer lab, play ground and garden are housed. There are 19 permanent teaching and 10 non-teaching staff. The average number of learners each academic year is about 500.

It is an aided institution receiving salary grant from Karnataka state government. It is included under 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act. It is accredited at B+ level by NAAC in February 2005.

Formerly the college was affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad until 2006. And since the inception of Karnataka State Women's University, Bijapur, the college has got permanent affiliation from Women's University.

### **S.J.M.Vidyapeetha.**

S.J.M.Vidyapeetha is established under the auspice of Sri Jagadguru Murugharajendra Brihanmatha which is a noted religious centre in Karnatak. The Matha is having a commendable tradition for the past three centuries and is rendering its service in the religious, social and educational spheres and in bringing transformation in the society. Admission and Evaluation procedure.

Eligibility for Admission:

Eligibility for admission to B.A and B.Com course is pass in the two years Pre-university examination of the Pre-University Education Board, Bangalore or an examination of any other University or Board recognized as equivalent thereto.

Application should be in the prescribed application form along with the required documents and admission fees. Fee structure is as per the norms of the University and the government of Karnataka. Fee concession is provided to the students of low income group.

## **Evaluation Procedure.**

Maximum marks in each subject is 100. It is divided into 80+20 (Theory+Internal). The University conducts a theory examination carrying 80 marks in all the subjects. 20 marks are for internal assessment – two internals of 10 marks each in each semester. The marks secured by the students in the internals are entered into the Input sheets and sent to the University. These marks are added to the theory marks at the time of the declaration of the results of the semester examination. Attendance to internal tests is compulsory as there is no second chance for attending the internals.

### **Rules and Regulations.**

1. The students should follow the rules and regulations issued by the college from time to time, failing which disciplinary action will be taken against them.
2. Regular attendance to the classes and tests is compulsory. A minimum of 75% attendance in each subject is essential. Otherwise they will not be eligible to appear for the semester exam.
3. Students should not indulge in such activities either in the premises or outside the college which will affect the discipline of the college.
4. Students are requested to notice the display board.

### **Library – Rules and Regulations.**

The college has a well-equipped library. Except on Sundays and government holidays, the library will be open from 10 am to 5.30pm and from 10 am to 2.30pm on Saturdays.

1. The students should have identity card and borrowers card for getting books from the library.
2. Each student will get two books for a week.
3. Books should be returned within time. Otherwise late fee will be charged.
4. If the books are spoiled or lost by the students they will be charged double the amount of the book.
5. Students are not allowed to take home reference books and periodicals.

## Student support Activities.

### I. Students Union.

Students union is formed to promote the extra-curricular activities and allround development of learners. The union's various wings-cultural activities, sports, debating and welfare aim at bringing out the potential competency of the students. The students representatives of the union are nominated on the basis of their academic merit. These are –

N.S.S. unit consists of 100 students. It undertakes activities which lead to the development of leadership qualities and social responsibility among the younger generation.

#### UGC Book Bank facility:-

Under this scheme the students may get one book for the whole year on application. Preference is given to meritorious students.

#### The Students Lending Library:-

There is a provision for lending two books for a year to the poor students. Selection of such students will be made on the basis of their merit, income and good conduct.

Grievances redressal Cell:-

The teachers in charge of this cell try to redress the grievances expressed by the students with personal care.

Career guidance and counseling Cell:- Guides the students by providing information about the career opportunities and higher education.

Scholarships:

Students can avail of various scholarships made available by the central and state governments and incentive prizes instituted by local donors.
